I am indeed honored to have this opportunity to present before you the consistent upward graph of our school's achievements and I would like to thank each one of you for being a significant part of this glorious journey.

INAUGURATION OF THE ACADEMIC YEAR

The new academic year vivaciously started on 1st June with much enthusiasm and with lot of dreams. The reopening day commenced with an invocation of blessing on all the members by Rev Fr. Johny Puthenveetil. The newly appointed Manger Sr.Therese and the former PTA president Mr. Viswanathan Nair were present on that special day. The inspiring message and various artistic performances made the day memorable. The students who brought laurels to the school with their good score for the board

exams were awarded so as to inspire and motivate other children to begin the academic year with more energy and passion.

ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

The year 2023 commenced on a wonderful note when the results of our 10th and 12th Board Exam came out. We are happy to share the details of the commendable performances of our students. In class XII, out of 29 students, 4 scored A1 in all the subjects and 21 students got distinction. Aparna B. of XII, Science stream, and Anu B.M. of XII, Commerce stream emerged as the school toppers by scoring 480 and 455 marks respectively. In class X, among 82 students 54 got distinction and Siva Soorya became the topper by securing 487 marks.

STAFF ENRICHMENT PROGRAMS

Our teachers constantly strive to stay updated by attending workshops and various training programs. Our staff, with the staff of our three sister schools participated a training program led by Mr. Sibin Antony M.V., a qualified trainer. In the month of May, an orientation program on 'Skill for Adolescence' was conducted by Lions Club Kovalam,. Teachers got the opportunity to attend the session on 'Innovation in Education for the new generations' by the resource person from MacMillan publishers. STUDENTS ENRICHMENT PROGRAM

The training session was conducted under the direction of senior doctors from Sree Chitira Thirunal Institute for Medical Science & Technology ,and PRS hospital. Stars Day is arranged after each exam and students who score A1 and A2 were awarded scholar star badges. Special badges were awarded to the students who have shown their excellence in academics without tuition. Systematic remedial classes and special counseling sessions are also arranged to ensure academic excellence of every child.

Each class takes turn to present a well-planned assembly based on a special theme and value. Every child is given the platform to display their talents. The students from the audience are given opportunity to give the feedback and appreciation to the performers.
